Grant will help Quest increase capacity for SharePoint business consulting and application development in Indiana.

June 26, 2009 (INDIANAPOLIS, IN) — Quest Information Systems, Inc., announced it was recently awarded a Technology Enhancement Certification for Hoosiers (TECH) grant from the Indiana Economic Development Corporation. The funds will be used to train information technology workers in Microsoft Office SharePoint® Server, a solution that is being more widely adopted and growing faster than any other server product in Microsoft history.

SharePoint is an integrated suite of server capabilities that helps organizations with content/document management, collaboration, information sharing and enterprise search. Already a Microsoft Gold Certified Partner, Quest earned an additional certification as a provider of SharePoint Deployment Planning Services (SDPS) in 2008. The solution has matured as a product over the last few years and there is considerable interest in deploying it. While the demand is increasing, there is a shortage of qualified service providers. Quest's strategy is to develop greater organizational capabilities and capacity to become the key Microsoft partner in Indiana. The grant was awarded to help the company train more of its current and future employees and help them obtain industry certifications to deliver the SharePoint services.

The TECH Fund is a reimbursement grant designed to help Indiana companies increase the number of certified IT employees in order to meet new and changing needs in advanced e-business enabling applications. Organizations that employ Indiana residents in advanced IT occupation are eligible. Quest's \$34,000 grant will cover half of its training budget. "We appreciate the opportunity to partner with IEDC to grow high-value jobs and contribute to Indiana's position as a technology leader," expressed Quest CEO Steve McNear. "As Indiana businesses and government agencies increasingly realize the benefits of SharePoint, Quest will continue to build capabilities to leverage SharePoint to improve their business processes."
